PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

4/24/19

The City of Randleman Board of Aldermen will hold a public hearing during their regularly scheduled meeting on May 7, 2019 at 6:00 PM or as soon thereafter as the agenda will allow. The purpose of the public hearing will be to consider public comment regarding proposed amendments, additions, and deletions to the City of Randleman Code of Ordinances. The proposed ordinances to be changed include the following:

- 1). Amending Sec. 6-34. Investigative Authority of Police
- 2). Amending Sec. 6-37. Fines for Violation of Sec. 6-36
- 3). Amending Sec. 14-63 Removal of Weeds, Trash and Debris
- 4). Amending Sec. 32-18. Unlawful Riding
- 5). Repealing Sec. 6-32. License and Registration – Required; fee; exemptions.
- 6). Repealing Sec. 6-33. Same – Tag and Collar; expiration date.
- 7). Adding Sec. 10-65. Exception to Noise Regulations (Commerce Square Events) to give exception to the City of Randleman and others as listed in the ordinance regarding the City's noise ordinance regulations whenever approved listed City events occur.
- 8). Adding Sec. 14-64. Annual Notice to Chronic Violators of Public Nuisance Ordinance to create an ordinance to define a chronic violator of public nuisance ordinance and steps to be taken to remedy the violations.
- 9). Adding Sec. 22-35. Human Waste to prohibit human waste on listed places.
- 10). Adding Sec. 26-36. Smoking and Littering on City Properties to define designated areas where smoking will be limited to during public events on public properties and allocating a fine to offenders who litter on city property.

11). Adding Sec. 32-72. Parking Fines and Penalties to assign a fine amount per offense and including instructions on when and where to pay said fine.
